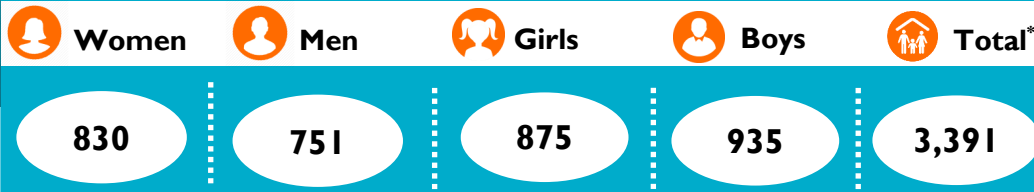

Toolkits and messages

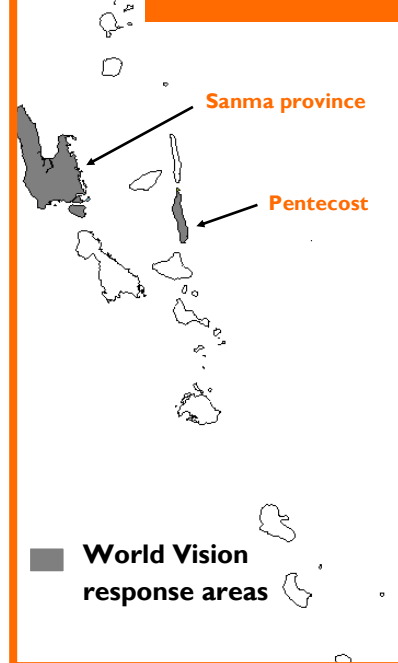
Shelter toolkits - items include nails, a hammer, handsaw, hoe, shears, a machete, rope & wire.

Hygiene kits - items include soap, toothbrushes, nappies, underwear, sanitary items & toilet paper.

Ending violence packages provide information on safety and planning for managing and mitigating increased risks of gender-based violence in the aftermath of a disaster.

COVID-19 messages shared at distributions on the importance of good hand hygiene and social distancing. Bamboo tippy taps were installed at distributions.
