



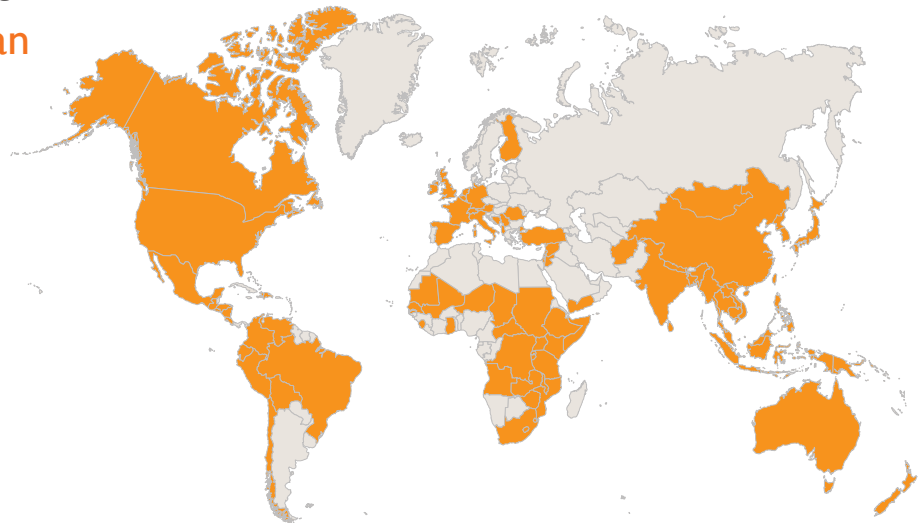
COVID-19 Emergency Response

World Vision's Key Concerns

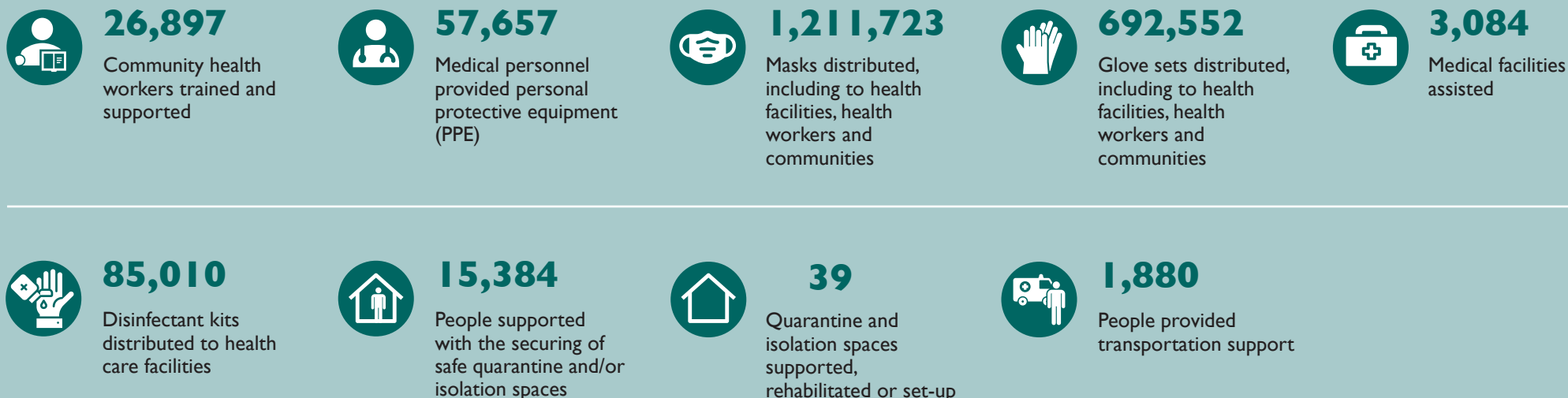
