


# COVID-19 Emergency Response May-July **2020**

151,720 IEC materials printed and distributed



63,832 hand-washing supplies e.g. soap, detergents) distributed



9,327 cleaning kits distributed to vulnerable communities



388 WASH facilities (excluding public hand-washing stations) constructed or rehabilitated



1,944 faith leaders disseminating preventive measures for COVID-19


