Water, Sanitation & Hygiene

Our goal is to provide clean water and sanitation to everyone in every community where we work, including those in the hardest-to-reach places. World Vision's strategy includes building water infrastructure, such as boreholes, latrines and sewage systems, as well as promoting good hygiene to protect the spread of disease.

Citizen Voice & Action

We endeavour to provide a voice of authority for children and families to speak out about their needs and effect change. Empowering communities is essential to World Vision's strategy to enabling lasting change. Partnering with community, tribal and religious leaders has allowed greater opportunities to generate positive change for children and their families.

Education

World Vision is working to ensure all children have the opportunity to learn basic literacy, numeracy and life skills. We help ensure that girls and boys are educated so that they can reach their full potential and contribute to their communities and countries.

Health & Nutrition

Our goal is to improve health status for children and their families. We focus on good nutrition, protection from infection and disease, and access to essential health services to improve health and reduce mortality.

Livelihoods & Resilience

Because productive and resilient livelihoods are key to breaking the cycle of poverty, we empower families to provide well for children by strengthening skills and improving access to capital and markets.

Humanitarian Emergency Response

Through our disaster management and response, we help prepare communities who are vulnerable to disaster and provide short-term relief, food, shelter and medical care to people when natural or man-made disasters happen.

Faith & Development

We collaborate with people who share our values towards children: compassion, love, and mercy. Believing that God works through all people, we work with those who are like-minded to reach the most vulnerable children in the most dangerous places.

We work with communities to prevent abuse, exploitation, and other violence against children, to ensure this is addressed effectively if and when it occurs and to help restore child survivors.
