Floods response

Together with our partners we reached an estimated **2.4 million** vulnerable people across South Darfur, East Darfur, South Kordofan and Blue Nile states. This was through food, security and livelihoods, health and nutrition, education, child protection and water, sanitation and hygiene (WASH) interventions, including COVID-19 and floods response.

Health and Nutrition

World Vision's interventions included providing free outpatient consultations for vulnerable populations living in internally displaced persons camps, refugee camps and host communities, conducting active case finding of malnutrition cases as well as mass screening, and providing nutrition care and treatment for children, pregnant and lactating women with malnutrition. These populations also benefitted from free antenatal care, laboratory, immunisation, medicine and access to trained and experienced health personnel.

Amidst the pandemic, World Vision Sudan remained steadfast in its commitment to deliver much-needed assistance to the most vulnerable populations supported through livelihoods and resilience interventions, including cash and food assistance.



FINANCIAL SUMMARY

World Vision Sudan's funding increased from US\$ 33,960,131 in FY 2019 to US\$ 42,545,599 in FY 2020 a nearly 30% growth. Multilateral funding accounted for more than 57% (24,496,385) of funding portfolio, while Government grants (US\$ 13,403,390) and Private Non-Sponsorship (US\$ 4,645,824) accounted for 32% and 11% of funding respectively.
