

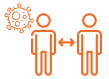

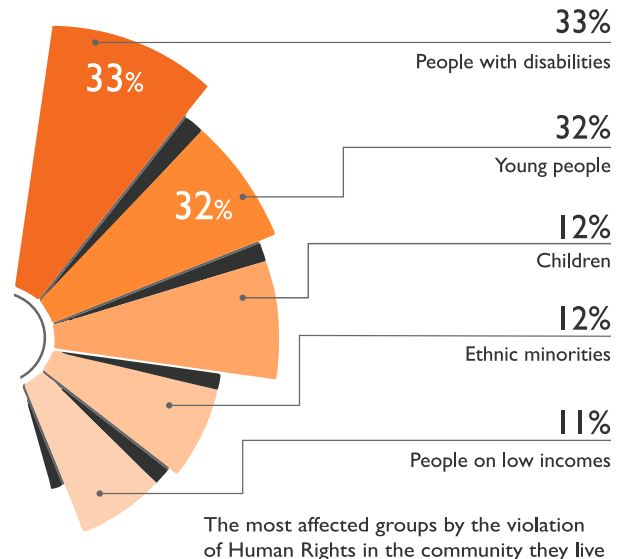
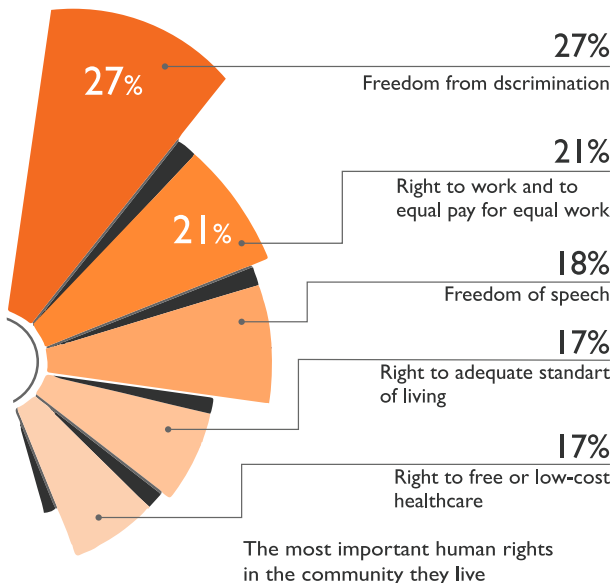
Self-efficacy*



Hopeful about the changes that can make on Human Rights in their community**

During the projects implementation, adolescents and youth have enhanced their feeling of efficacy to make Albania more democratic and more inclusive of human rights.

There is a decline in youth positivism for the future.



* according to the internal report within the grant 11.2% of young people report higher values of self-efficacy

** according to the internal report within the grant -1.3% of young people are more positive for the future
