FACTS

- 595 natural disasters have occurred in China in the past two decades, which have killed 114,064 people, affected 1,743,485,330 people and caused direct economic losses of \$510 billion.
- China is ranked 40th in the world on children's exposure to climate and environmental hazards, shocks and stresses.

We focus on community-based disaster risk management and integrate disaster risk reduction into development programmes through awareness-raising campaigns, facility installation, community-level training, simulations and mechanism reinforcement.



KEY INTERVENTIONS

Participatory hazard, vulnerability, and capacity assessment

Empower communities to measure hazards, risks, and also their own resources and capacities to inform the community disaster preparedness plans as well as the follow-up disaster risk reduction activities

Community disaster preparedness plans & early warning system

Support the communities to establish community-level disaster preparedness plans, including contingency plans based on local risk assessments and regular training drills held to enhance disaster response capacity. The plans also capture the dissemination of early warnings and special arrangements for vulnerable groups such as people with disabilities.

Community drills and awareness raising

Organise inclusive evacuation drills with the participation of local authorities, community people, and other stakeholders, utilising the established early warning system

Sustainable resilient community development & demonstration

Improve knowledge and technical capacity for Chinese CSOs to deliver inclusive, accountable preparedness and resilience-building services to disaster-prone communities, in line with (inter) national standards

Empower disaster-prone communities to effectively prepare for and respond to shocks and stressors

Localise disaster risk reduction (inter)national standards and policies
