FACTS

- Cambodia is susceptible to floods, flash floods, drought, and storms
- 175,872 households were affected by the Flood in 2022 with 14,299 households being displaced

World Vision International-Cambodia involves children in dialogues concerning disaster risk reduction and climate crisis response and escalates their recommendations to the government actors.



KEY INTERVENTIONS

Community-based disaster risk reduction

Involve children, youth, women, people with disabilities and government authorities in assessing and reducing disaster risks and thus increasing community resilience

Facilitate the development of disaster preparedness and response plans at district level, and stimulate partnerships between key actors and the private sector in providing assistance to disaster-affected people

Safe school framework

Ensure school safety by establishing safe learning facilities, school disaster management, and risk reduction and resilience education

Climate change interventions by community members

Strengthen communities' capacity for disaster risk management and catalyse community-led climate change mitigation interventions for the well-being of their children
