COUNTRY BACKGROUND

India is prone to multiple disasters mainly comprised of floods, cyclones, landslides, droughts, earthquakes, heat waves, and wild fire.

World Vision India has been working with communities in 118 projects across the country on community disaster preparedness initiatives, developing community task forces with special skills in early warning, search and rescue, first aid, shelter management, and WASH. World Vision India has also been working on ecosystem-based initiatives such as farmer-managed natural regeneration, community-level water management, improving green cover, and clean energy applications. School-safety programme is also a priority in all operational areas.



KEY INTERVENTIONS

Children sensitisation

Encourage and enable children to speak in various platforms to express their views on disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation to wide range of stakeholders



Community disaster preparedness

Facilitate the development and updating of community-level disaster preparedness plans and equip community task force members to become capable first responders in place



Land restoration

Introduce various initiatives to promote sustainable and climate-resilient agricultural practices such as farm/community pond creation, tree sapling planting, and farmer-managed natural regeneration

Clean energy applications

Promote fuel-efficient alternatives such as cookstoves, solar irrigation pumps, solar lightings
