


World Vision has been responding to Iraq's humanitarian crisis since 2014 and works with Syrian refugees, internally displaced persons (IDPs), host communities and returnees. In line with the transitioning environment in Iraq and the movement of people in need, World Vision Iraq is shifting operations and re-strategizing its response. Iraq is a complex area with prevalent needs in both response and development. Sharing the vision of Humanitarian Development and Peace Nexus, WV Iraq's programmatic approach is to assist communities to recover more sustainably from various shocks and disasters as well as building on resilience and economic and climate reintegration, justice. strengthening systems, while continually addressing issues of hunger and basic needs.

WV Iraq's current strategy has four dimensions (Ministry Impact, Ministry Funding, Operational Excellence and People, Learning & Growth). We focus on these core sectors: WASH, Education/Protection, Health/MHPSS and Cash & Livelihoods contributing to child well-being outcomes, with reach of 593,528 people in FY20 and FY21 and 417,047 in 2022. Our cross cutting themes include Faith and Development, Gender Equality and Inclusion (GESI), social cohesion environment/climate change. WV Iraq continues to geographically expand and grow its presence to respond to the evolving needs of vulnerable boys and girls, including their families and communities. We currently operate in seven governorates i.e. Erbil, Duhok and Suleihmania (KRI) and Kirkuk, Ninewa, Salahaddin and Anbar (GoI).

## WHAT WE DO



### **CASH & LIVELIHOODS**

We assist crisis-affected communities through income generating opportunities, cash plus activities, safety net and livelihoods diversification, value chain development, technical skills training and life skills coaching.



### **CLIMATE CHANGE**

We work with farming communities on CC mitigation and adaptation efforts with approaches such as Farmer Managed Natural Regeneration (FMNR) to enhance people's meaningful participation on climate actions.



## EDUCATION AND CHILD PROTECTION

We work to support children and youth, providing psychosocial support, ensuring their protection and addressing disruption of education as a result of conflict and displacement.



# GENDER EQUALITY AND SOCIAL INCLUSION

We work with communities to ease restrictive socio-cultural norms, rebalance unequal power relations and reform disempowering systems to meet the most vulnerable people's needs and create sustainable change for the children of Iraq.

We work to support children and youth, providing psychosocial support, ensuring their protection and addressing disruption of education as a result of conflict and displacement.



#### **WASH**

We ensure adequate access to safe, equitable and sustainable clean water, dignified sanitation and education of appropriate hygiene behaviours and practices for children and families.

We work with diverse faith leaders to raise awareness on child wellbeing issues and promote social cohesion. By deepening our partnership with multi-faith leaders, we ignite positive and lasting change driven by faith convictions.
