## Course description

**Reducing Anaemia:** This six-week on-the-job training course helps learners understand maternal and childhood anaemia, its multiple causes and how to address this issue in the community.

**Reducing Childhood Stunting Part 1 (multisectoral):** Part 1 of this on-the-job training course is a six-week introduction to childhood stunting that



explores how every sector contributes to the reduction of stunting via different pathways. This course is useful for staff from various sectors who want to understand their role in addressing stunting.

**Reducing Childhood Stunting Part 2 (nutrition-specific):** Part 2 is an eight-week course on nutrition-specific interventions along the life cycle that help to prevent childhood stunting.

# Ready to learn?

World Vision has created an eLearner Readiness Passport (<a href="https://cmam.wvncoe.org/eLearner/">https://cmam.wvncoe.org/eLearner/</a>), a practical tool that identifies the key skills and resources that the individual must manage in the online environment and awards a visa if the learner is 'ready to learn'. You will need to fill out the questionnaire prior to registering, as the results are required for registration.

#### Cost

The subsidized price is \$150 USD per learner per course. We also offer an annual membership option for groups of four or more learners: \$250 USD per individual learner for the year (a savings of \$200 USD if taking all 3 courses and savings of \$50 USD if taking 2 courses).
