WORLD VISION'S RESPONSE



135,250 people have received food packs



10,000 families, reaching 50,000 people, have received items including tarps, ropes, blankets and sleeping mats

100 of the most vulnerable families have received tents, including set-up support

2018 families have received kitchen sets which include pans, cups, a jug, bowls, plates, spoons and a bucket



1,000 children are regularly attending dedicated spaces where they can play and interact with other children in a safe environment



7,529 children under five have been screened for acute malnutrition with 2,698 (35%) suspected cases referred for treatment

4,385 pregnant and lactating women have received counselling on good hygiene practices, the importance of breastfeeding and complementary feeding after six months



4,900 families have received hygiene kits and 9,800 jerry cans reaching 24,500 people

13,950 people have attended hygiene orientation sessions

480 latrines have been installed reaching 24,000 people
