DID YOU KNOW?

- 9 out of 10 of Cambodia's poor live in rural villages where access to services is still lacking
- Only 46.5% have access to an improved water source
- 1 61% of students only reach grade 6
- The infant mortality rate stands at 28 deaths per 1,000 live births

30 districts and 290 communes (24 new and 6 current I-SAF) in Takeo, Kampong Cham, Pursat, Battambang, and Kampong Speu



PROJECT Overall Objective

Overall Objective:

Strengthen and expand the demand side of social accountability in the sub-national democratic development reform process to improve public service delivery in Cambodia, specifically in primary schools (PS), health centers (HC), and communes.

KEY PROJECT OUTCOMES INCLUDE


- Citizens have improved knowledge on their rights, service standards and budget information. Measure 60% of citizens from baseline survey participating in I-SAF can cite standards for PSs, HCs, and commune services and expenditure for PS, HC and commune budgets.
- Improved performance and budgets of citizen-prioritized public services, through citizen monitoring and SNA engagement. Measure - 45% of PSs, HCs, and communes demonstrate improved service delivery performance.
- Improved capacity of Community Accountability
 Facilitators (CAFs), Civil Society Organizations
 (CSOs), and SNAs for quality SAF implementation
 and improved government policy implementation
 through joint learning agendas and strengthened
 M&E reporting. Measure 70% of CAFs
 demonstrate the capacity to facilitate I-SAF by 2020.
