




Nepal Earthquake Recovery Programme (NERP) overview

Goal: improving the wellbeing and resilience of women, men, girls and boys in two earthquake-affected districts

NERP is a two year programme focusing on:

- Agro-support and resilience: Agro-inputs, linkages, trainings on agro-business, post harvest management, collection centres, community asset rehabilitation like roads, irrigation canals, Disaster Risk Reduction.
- Enterprise Development: Market need assessment, market linkages, savings groups, supporting income generation activities.
- Employment Skills and Training: Labour market assessment, vocational and entrepreneurship training, soft skill training, job fairs.

High-Level Summary

70% activity achievement rate

Activities completed to-date

55% expenditure rate

CADI, 171,341 as of December 31, 2017

9,150 individuals reached

4,771 females, 4,379 males in Nuwakot and Gorkha district

Agro-inputs distributions (1,830 vulnerable conflict affected households reached):

- 89% reported increased income as a result of the livestock support provided by WVIN
- 85% used improved tools vs 15% who have not used it
- 91% (n=325) used the improved seed we provided and Out of them - 56% said that the seeds helped in increased production
