#### FACTS ABOUT CHILD HEALTH

**5.9** MILLION CHILDREN

under age 5 died in 2015

R.I.P

nearly **16,000** every day

despite remarkable declines in under 5 mortality since 2000

**83%** OF DEATHS

in children under age 5 are caused by infectious, neonatal or nutritional conditions<sup>16</sup>



#### WORLD VISION'S RESPONSE

**US\$225** MILLION invested in health and HIV and a further **US\$109** MILLION in WASH<sup>17</sup>

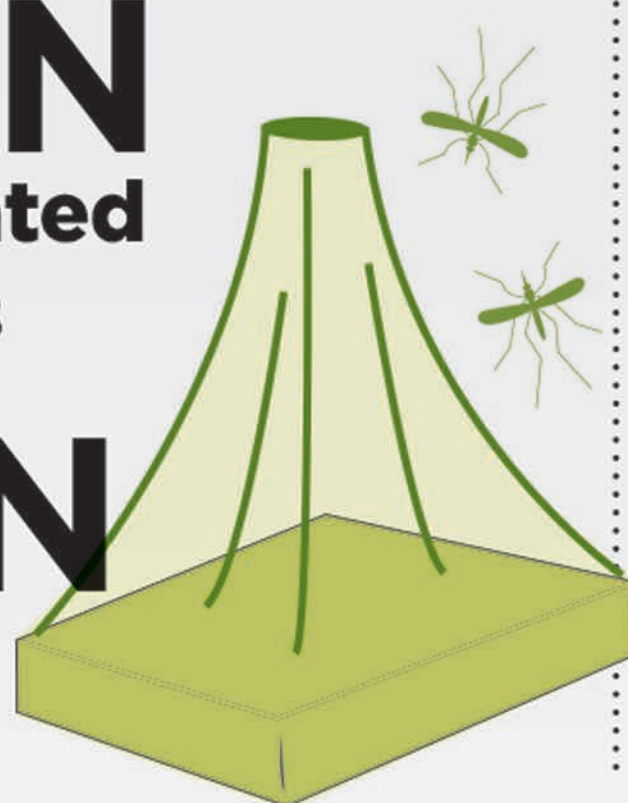
