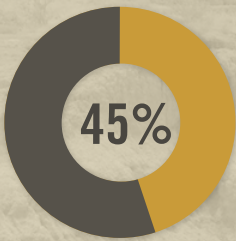

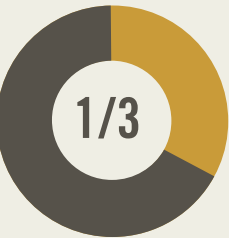
5 UNFORTUNATE FACTS ABOUT HUNGER AROUND THE WORLD

Globally, **165 MILLION** under-five year olds are stunted, **100 MILLION** are underweight and **51 MILLION** are wasted as they do not have enough nutritious food for a healthy life.

Poor nutrition causes nearly half (45%) of preventable deaths in children under 5 years of age – **3.1 MILLION** children each year.



66 MILLION primary school-age children attend classes hungry across the developing world, with **23 MILLION** in Africa alone.



One-third of the food produced worldwide is wasted, costing the global economy around **US\$750 BILLION** per year.

Many poor farmers are unable to grow enough food to feed their own families, much less sell for additional income.
