






5 UNFORTUNATE FACTS ABOUT HUNGER AROUND THE WORLD



Globally, 165 MILLION under-five year olds are stunted, 100 MILLION are underweight and 51 MILLION are wasted as they do not have enough nutritious food for a healthy life.

Poor nutrition causes nearly half (45%) of preventable deaths in children under 5 years of age $-\,3.1\,$ MILLION children each year.



66 MILLION primary school-age children attend classes hungry across the developing world, with **23 MILLION** in Africa alone.









One-third of the food produced worldwide is wasted, costing the global economy around ${f US\$750~BILLION}$ per year.

Many poor farmers are unable to grow enough food to feed their own families, much less sell for additional income.
